About MAHFH

Mission: Seeking to put God's love into action, Habitat for Humanity brings people together to build homes, communities, and hope.

Macon Area Habitat for Humanity was created out of a Sunday School class at Northminster Presbyterian Church in 1986 as an expression of faith in action to address Macon's serious need for affordable homeownership opportunities. The first house was completed in 1987 in the Pleasant Hill neighborhood. The organization remained a volunteer-only nonprofit until 1996 when it hired its first staff members. Today, Macon Area Habitat for Humanity is located at 690 Holt Avenue and has nine permanent staff members. Through collaboration with the Macon community, over 140 families have been served by the affiliate. In 2006, Macon Area Habitat opened the ReStore, selling new and used home improvement supplies to generate revenue to build more homes with Macon families. Since its beginning, Macon Area Habitat for Humanity's volunteers, supporters, and have staff believed that we have the unique opportunity to express our faith in God and love for our fellow brothers and sisters through this dynamic ministry of homebuilding. Millard Fuller, founder of Habitat for Humanity International, wrote, "Habitat is just one huge expression of God's love."

HOMEOWNERSHIP

Macon Area Habitat builds houses in partnership with families who demonstrate a need for housing, the ability to pay, and also a willingness to partner. These homes are sold, not given, to approved homeowner applicants. Moving into and owning a Habitat home improves the quality of life for its residents, not only in their physical surroundings but also by instilling a sense of pride and responsibility which comes with homeownership.

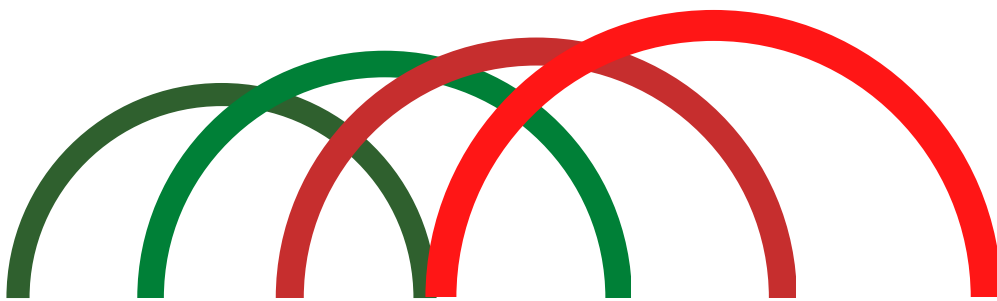
Macon Area Habitat for Humanity's Light More Homes annual Christmas light display brings Joy to thousands each year and helps us literally "light more homes" by raising funds to provide electrical work for Habitat homes in Macon-Bibb and Jones Counties each year.



Light More Homes was located at Chick-fil-A on Tom Hill Sr. Blvd for 12 years before moving to Mercer Village in 2020 to continue our standing partnership with Mercer University. Nearby restaurants like Margarita's, joined our long-standing sponsors as we installed a 52,000 light canopy that spanned Montpelier Avenue and created a gorgeous holiday setting. Candy Cane Lane was created in 2021 and has become a huge part of the show, stretching the length of Stadium Dr. and covering over 180 trees. Habitat Construction Model

Macon Area Habitat for Humanity (MAHFH) is an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International, an ecumenical Christian housing ministry devoted to ending substandard housing across the globe. Houses are built using volunteer labor and in-kind donations and then sold to partner families at no-interest and no-profit. Habitat homes are designed to be safe, secure and energy efficient for the families we serve. At the same time Habitat homes are designed to allow for volunteer involvement in every step of construction. The Habitat model welcomes anyone who has a heart for service to work on our job site. Skilled volunteers help move the construction timeline forward with their ability to work independently or lead small groups of volunteers on assigned tasks. Under the close supervision of our Construction team, volunteers with little to no construction experience are a valuable part of our mission and contribute greatly to the construction of our mission. There is a job and a place for everyone on our construction site.

Thematic Builds

- **Women Build:** An annual event held in Macon for over 20 years. Corporate teams of women from across the globe volunteer for their area's Habitat affiliate and come together to sponsor, build, and dedicate a home. It is a unique partnership of female community leaders and companies focused on women as mentors and executives.
- **Board Build:** This build is sponsored and planned by the MAHFH Executive Board.
- **Youth Build:** A build completed in partnership with the Bibb County School District and funded through a YouthBuild grant. This build allows students to complete their high school diploma or earn their GED while completing requirements for a Construction Certificate through hands on experience on a Habitat job site.
- **Blitz Build:** With their professional experience, career homebuilders utilize their diverse trade skills and in-kind donations to fund and build a Habitat home.
- **Faith Build:** A home constructed through the prayers, volunteer and financial support of the local faith community.
